Over 1'000 visitors at the Music exhibition

The exhibition dedicated to the Italian-Slovenian artist Zoran Music (1909-2005) has attracted over 1'200 visitors in thirty days of being opened. At the one thousand visitor, Mrs. Maria Shichkova Pacolli, director of Fondazione Ibrahim Kodra of Melide, the Fondazione Braglia gifted a copy of the volume *Zoran Music. La Collezione Braglia*, published by Hirmer Verlag.

An important visit was made by Cathrin Klingsöhr-Leroy, director of the Franz Marc Museum in Kochel am See in Germany with whom the Braglia Foundation is collaborating towards an important exhibit on German Expressionism.
